Whole School Transition Program

Congratulations to all staff and students for a brilliant start to our whole school Transition program yesterday afternoon. We welcomed our 2019 prep students and our current students spent time in their 2019 class cohort. The whole school transition program will continue every Wednesday afternoon from 2pm – 3pm until early December and the state-wide Orientation day is on Tuesday 11th December.

2019 Parent Payments

In 2019, all students will again be required to purchase a book pack containing stationery for use in the classroom. Stationery is classed as an **Essential Education item** that parents are responsible for ensuring that their child is provided with. This week all children received a detailed information letter regarding the 2019 payments. If you did not receive this information from your child, please check their school bag or contact the office for a new letter. Once payment is made, the book pack will be delivered to the classroom for distribution to the student. Payments will be accepted at the office until Wednesday 19th December 2018 and then from Tuesday 29th January 2019. Alternatively, parents are encouraged to pay at a convenient time using BPay.

If your child's 2019 Essential Education items levy is **paid in full** by Monday 17th December you will automatically go in the draw to win a \$100 school uniform voucher from our uniform supplier Noone Image wear in Hoppers Crossing. Options are available to support parents with payment including making regular instalments via a Centrepay deduction. If you receive a Centrelink payment, please enquire at the office for more information about this service. A \$20 discount for each child will be applied if payment is received in full by the end of Term 1 2019. If you have any queries or wish to discuss your circumstances and the options available to you, please contact the school to make an appointment.

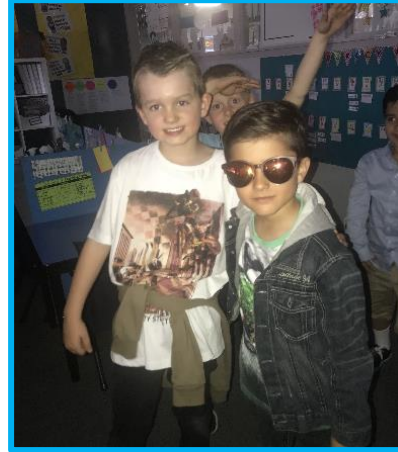
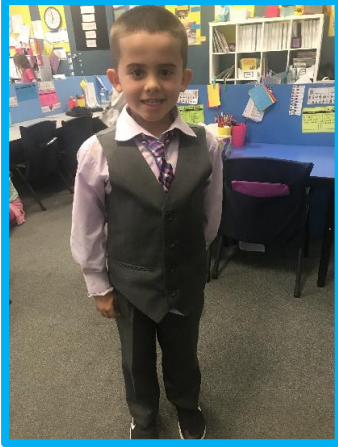

'I liked sleeping in my sleeping bag because it was so warm. I also liked making new friends with the girls in my room' **Hayley 2C**

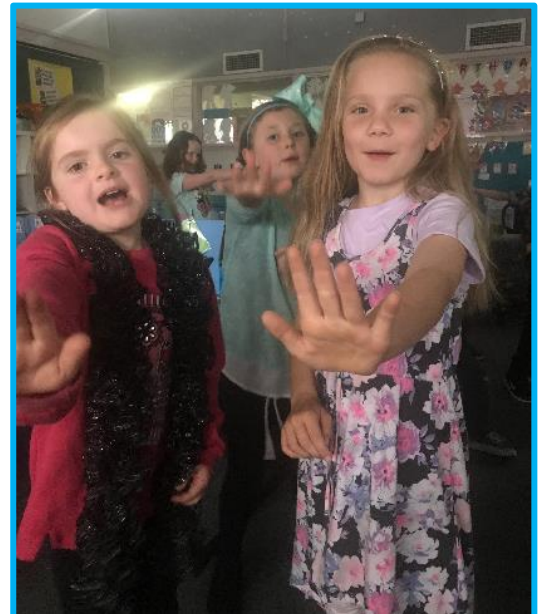
'My favourite part of the sleepover was sleeping in the bed and combing my hair' **Jaslin 2A**
