A message from the Principal Class Team...

Dear Parents, Carers, and students,

As restrictions ease, we have seen an increase in traffic on roads bordering our school. We ask all members of our school community to please be vigilant when dropping off and picking up your child from school. Please park your car in a permitted area and ensure that your child/children use the supervised school crossings. Please also encourage your child to use the marked school crossings even if the crossing supervisor has left.

We met with senior executives from Negri Contractors today to discuss the reconstruction works that will begin on roads around our school. Pavement and kerb removal works will begin next week, and as a result, Woodville Park Drive will be limited to local traffic only (only for those who live in the street). Parking around the school will be even more limited. You may need to leave home a little earlier, and park a little further away from the school and walk your children to the gate.

We are continuing to organise staff and class groupings for 2021. If your child/ren will not be returning to Woodville in 2021 we would appreciate it if you could notify the office in writing as soon as possible. The school email address is at the very top of this newsletter. If you have yet to enrol your child, Prep or otherwise for Woodville 2021, please contact the office as soon as possible to arrange a tour and an enrolment interview.

Transition across the school will look a lot different this year due to the Coronavirus pandemic. Invitations and emails have been sent to our 2021 Prep students inviting them to one of many scheduled small group transition sessions in week 9 of this term. These small groups are known as Bubbles. Unfortunately, due to the size and scale of secondary schools, and guidelines recommending reduced many of our local feeder secondary schools have decided to postpone the usual state-wide orientation day in December to the beginning of term one next year. Once again we thank you for your patience and understanding.

Finally, although parents/carers were given access to teacher email addresses during the COVID-19 remote learning period, we ask that you no longer use these. 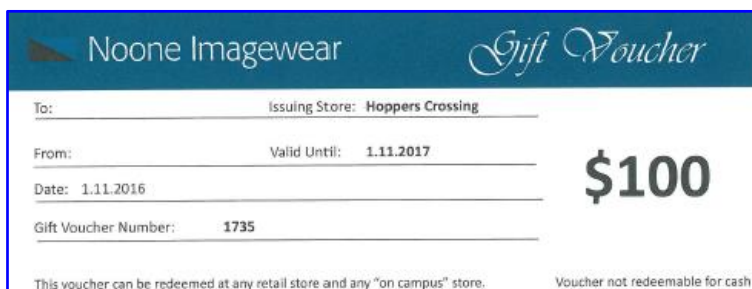

2020 Essential Education Levy

The School Council has determined the cost of the 2021 Essential Student Learning Items remain at \$220.00 per child, the same as this year.

In 2021, all students will again be required to purchase a book pack containing stationery for use in the classroom. Stationery is classed as an **Essential Education item** that parents are responsible for ensuring that their child is provided with. This week all children received a detailed information letter regarding the 2021 payments. If you did not receive this information from your child, please check their school bag or contact the office for a new letter. Once payment is made, the book pack will be delivered to the classroom for distribution to the student. Payments will be accepted at the office until Monday 14th December 2020 and then from Wednesday 27th January 2021. No payments will be accepted after Monday 14th December.

If your child's 2021 Essential Education items levy is **paid in full** by Monday 14th December you will automatically go in the draw to win a \$100 school uniform voucher from our uniform supplier Noone Image wear in Hoppers Crossing. Options are available to support parents with payment including making regular instalments via a Centrepay deduction. If you receive a Centrelink payment, please enquire at the office for more information about this service. A \$20 discount for each child will be applied if payment is received in full by the end of Term one 2021. If you have any queries or wish to discuss your circumstances and the options available to you, please contact the school to make an appointment.



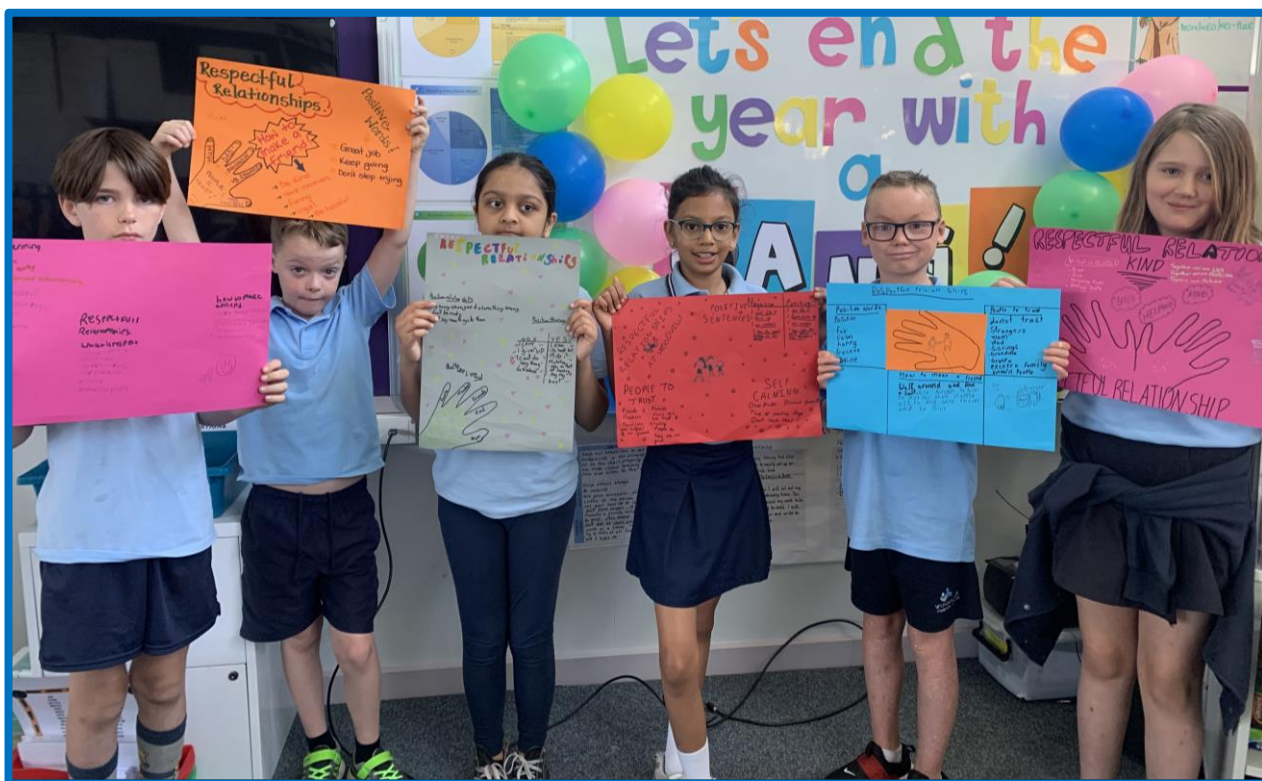
