

100 Days of School

Dear Parents / Carers

On Friday 29th July, Prep students will celebrate their 100th Day of School.

Festivities will include a special breakfast hosted by the Prep teachers, activities that will focus on the number 100, a costume parade and a disco to end the day.

Breakfast will consist of:

- Cereal – Rice Bubbles, Corn Flakes or Weetbix
- Toast with butter, strawberry jam or vegemite
- Fresh fruit
- Juice (orange or apple) or water (student's own drink bottle).

If your child has any food allergies and you do not wish for them to eat breakfast at school, please advise your child's teacher no later than Wednesday 27th July.

Please note that there is NO cost to families for the breakfast.

All students, regardless of whether they are participating in the special breakfast will be required to be at school no later than 8:50am.

Although optional, it is encouraged that students dress up as if they are 100 years old or in a way that represents the number 100. Costumes do not need to be elaborate; you can use everyday items found at home such as hair curlers, walking sticks, robes, shawls, toy glasses, braces etc. For safety reasons, please ensure that shoes are school appropriate.
