Exciting news!

We are jumping on board the Compass train and will be opening it live to parents/carers as of Monday 8th August!

An email and letter will be sent home to every family tomorrow, explaining what the Compass platform is, how to create your own personal log in password, and how to install the app to a smart phone or device. Staff have been busy participating in professional learning modules, learning about the various components of the communication platform. We invite all families to download the app and log in.

Once rolled out completely, Compass will be a communication platform which will enable the school, staff, students and families to be up to date with the latest news/events happening at Woodville. As well as a communication tool between home and school, Compass will provide an assessment and reporting space, booking parent/teacher interviews, student behaviour and wellbeing tracker, and attendance monitoring. The staff are excited to learn more, (as you no doubt will be too), however we do ask for your patience as staff learn about, master, then roll out to the community various elements of the Compass platform.

We will be hosting a log in day/afternoon where parents/carers can come up to school should they have any questions or difficulties logging on to the new Compass communication tool.

If you have a child who is eligible to come to school in 2023 (turning 5 years of age by April 30th, 2023), we are accepting enrolments now.

- Proof of residential address (Utility bill e.g. gas/electricity)

JPs provide a free and timely service that is accessible to all members of the community, making themselves available to act as an independent witness to documents that are used for official or legal purposes.

In Victoria, the role of a JP volunteer is administrative.

The primary role is focused on:

- attesting to the execution of a document
- witnessing a statutory declaration
- witnessing an affidavit for use in court
- certifying true copies of an original document
- certifying a person's identity.

This service is completely confidential.



Every Wednesday and Thursday afternoon from 4:30pm to 5:30pm, Mr S and Woodville will offer the service to our community.

If you need documents to be certified, witnessed or signed, you will be able to access this service in Room 2.
