Woodville Primary School is looking forward to another great year of teaching and learning in 2024 and would like to advise you of Woodville Primary School's voluntary financial contributions for GRADE TWO (2) 2024.

Schools provide students with free instruction to deliver the standard Victorian curriculum and we want to assure you that all contributions are voluntary. Nevertheless, the ongoing support of our families ensures that our school can offer the best possible education and support for our students. We want to thank you for your support, whether it's through fundraising or volunteering your time. This has made a huge difference to our school and the programs we can offer such as a wider offering of subjects, special curriculum experiences or enhanced digital learning opportunities.

Department of Education guidelines mandate that schools are unable to provide parents with a statement of fees. With this in mind, parents are asked to please review the recommended voluntary financial contributions schedule attached for an indication of contributions for your child/ren.

Woodville Primary School no longer provides the essential educational items for each student (ie: book packs). Parents/carers are asked to purchase the supplies for their own child for the 2024 school year. Further on in this letter is a list of the items we recommend be purchased for your child's personal use in the classroom along with the details of our regular supplier, WINC who have set up a "Parent Portal" where you can purchase the recommended items quite easily and at an extremely competitive price. *Order the complete book list on, or before Friday 8th December 2024 for free delivery to your front door.* Please be aware that if you only order a few items off the list you will have to pay delivery costs.

If you have unused stationery items at home from previous years and would like to donate them to the school, please feel free to drop them at the school office.

Woodville Primary School will continue to use subscriptions to online learning platforms to support the learning of all students (ie Literacy / Numeracy programs). Families are invited to make a voluntary contribution towards these programs (please see overpage for full details).

FREE INSTRUCTION

- Schools provide students with free instruction and ensure students have free access to all items, activities and services that are used by the school to fulfil the standard curriculum requirements in Victorian Curriculum F-10, VCE and VCAL.
- Schools may invite parents to make a financial contribution to support the school.



PARENT PAYMENT REQUESTS

Schools can request contributions from parents under three categories:

Curriculum Contributions

Voluntary financial contributions for curriculum items and activities which the school deems necessary for students to learn the Curriculum.

Other Contributions

Voluntary financial contributions for non-curriculum items and activities that relate to the school's functions and objectives.

Extra-Curricular Items and Activities

Items and activities that enhance or broaden the schooling experience of students and are above and beyond what the school provides for free to deliver the Curriculum. These are provided on a user-pays basis.

- Schools may also invite parents to supply or purchase educational items to use and own (e.g. textbooks, stationery, digital devices).



FINANCIAL HELP FOR FAMILIES

- Schools put in place financial hardship arrangements to support families who cannot pay for items or activities so that their child doesn't miss out.
- Schools have a nominated parent payment contact person(s) that parents can have a confidential discussion with regarding financial hardship arrangements.



SCHOOL PROCESSES

- Schools must obtain school council approval for their parent payment arrangements and publish all requests and communications for each year level on their school website for transparency.
