Woodville Primary School purchases a variety of subscriptions to online learning platforms to support the learning of all students (ie; English & Mathematics programs). Parents/carers are asked to purchase the supplies for their own child for the 2026 school year. Further on in this letter is a list of the items we recommend be purchased from stationary company WINC for your child's personal use in the classroom.

There is a "WINC Parent Portal" where you can purchase the recommended items quite easily and at an extremely competitive price. *Place your order on, or before December 5th 2025 for free delivery to your home* (do not use the school as delivery address). Please be aware that if you do not choose to purchase the complete pack and your order is less than \$60 a delivery fee will apply during the free delivery period.

We strongly encourage everyone to place their orders as soon as possible to avoid delivery delays and children can then bring their book packs to school on day one of 2026.

FREE INSTRUCTION

- Schools provide students with free instruction and ensure students have free access to all items, activities and services that are used by the school to fulfil the standard curriculum requirements in Victorian Curriculum F-10, VCE and VCAL.
- Schools may invite parents to make a financial contribution to support the school.

PARENT PAYMENT REQUESTS

Schools can request contributions from parents under three categories:



Curriculum Contributions Voluntary financial contributions for curriculum items and activities which the school

deems necessary for students to learn the Curriculum.

Other **Contributions**

Voluntary financial contributions for noncurriculum items and activities that relate to the school's functions and objectives.

Extra-Curricular Items and Activities

Items and activities that enhance or broaden the schooling experience of students and are above and beyond what the school provides for free to deliver the Curriculum. These are provided on a user-pays basis.

Schools may also invite parents to supply or purchase educational items to use and own (e.g. textbooks, stationery, digital devices).



FINANCIAL HELP FOR FAMILIES

- Schools put in place financial hardship arrangements to support families who cannot pay for items or activities so that their child doesn't miss out.
- Schools have a nominated parent payment contact person(s) that parents can have a confidential discussion with regarding financial hardship arrangements.



SCHOOL PROCESSES
