Capital Works Build

This project is a 10.7 million dollar project providing new and improved teaching and learning spaces. We are currently commencing by engaging in the formal first stage of the project's documentation. This stage is primarily sharing the mission and vision of the schools' goals and future directions for improved learning opportunities.

We are fortunate to be supported and guided by the VSBA and Lynne Sutton from the Department of Education in every part of the project: from planning to schematic design, to decanting and organising temporary classrooms and workspaces to the build itself. It is always helpful to have an experience mind supporting school-based decisions.

Sally Brincat, Principal Architect from Thomson Adsett who will help us to design the new build, visited our school on the first day of this term and facilitated a workshop for our staff, seeking their thoughts and opinions.

We will keep our community informed as we commence design discussions and may indeed open up conversations for community input.

COVID-19

The Victorian government has announced new arrangements for schools in Victoria. As part of this planned changes to keep our schools safe and reduce the impact of any future outbreaks, schools will be required to implement COVID-safe behaviours.

For the next couple of weeks we ask parents/carers to only enter the school grounds if it is absolutely necessary.

We ask families to discuss this and arrange meeting points outside of the school or at a particular gate. Families waiting at the gate must observe physical distancing and must wear a fitted face mask at all times.

If there is a need to enter the school grounds, parents/carers must check in using a mobile phone and the Victorian State Government QR code check in. QR codes can be found at each gate/entry point to the school.

Let's hope that this is a short term arrangement and we can once again welcome our families safely back into the school grounds. We appreciate your patience and understanding – this is what makes Woodville stand out from the crowd – our wonderfully supportive community spirit.

To enrol you will need to bring:

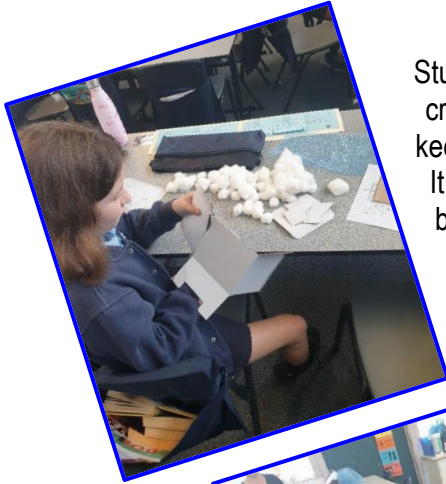
- Child's birth certificate

5/6 News Team

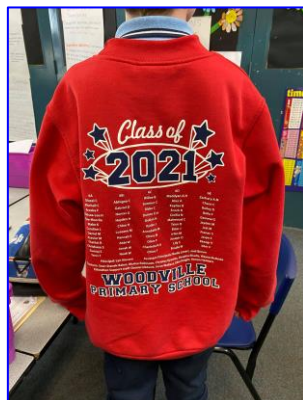
Hey 5/6 parents and carers,

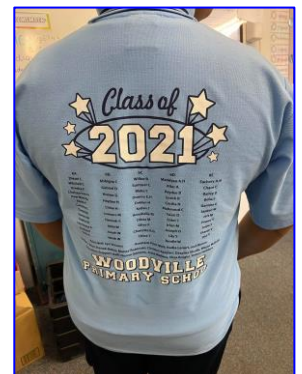
Over the last week or so, students have been working from home or learning online from home and we thank you, the families, and all students for supporting the change and for helping to make things run smoothly and effortlessly.

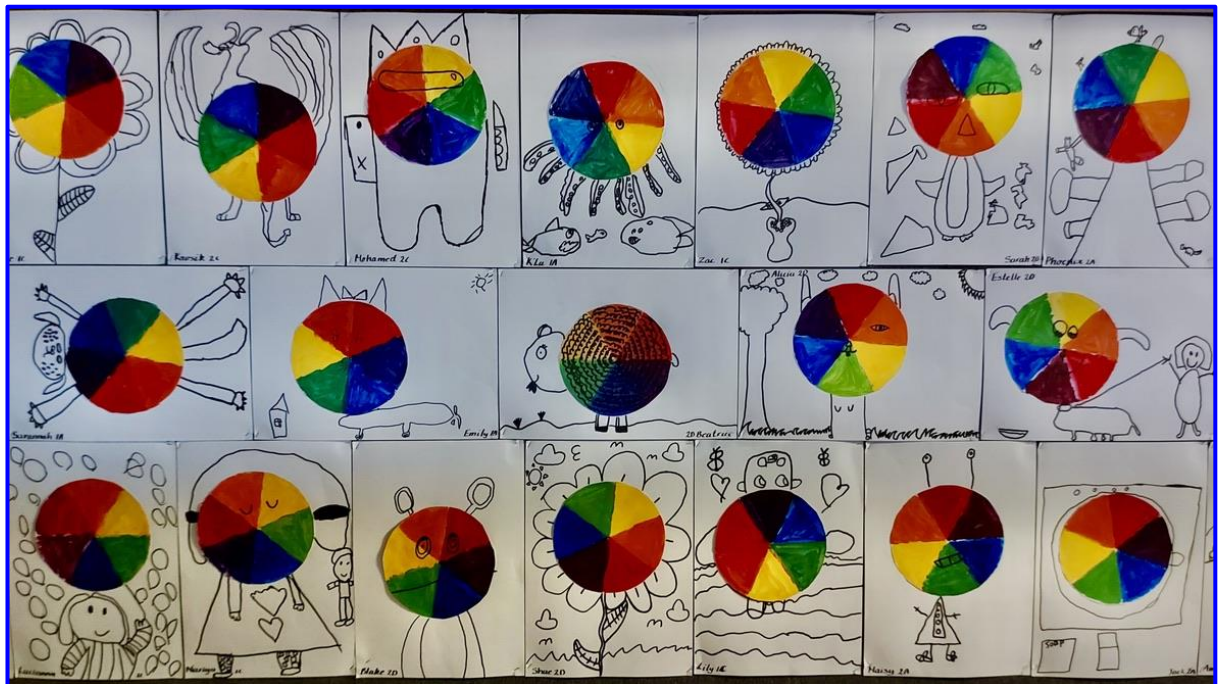
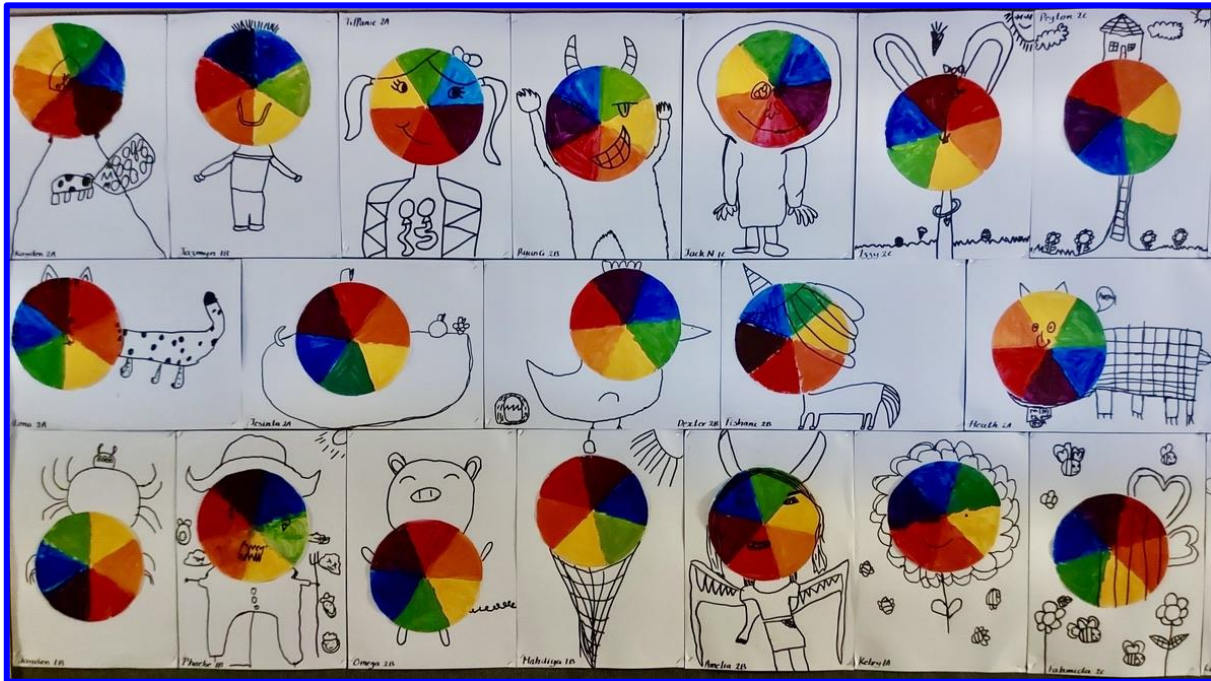
