Dear Parents/Carers,

We would like to invite your child to participate in our Whole School Transition program.

Starting school is a major life transition for children and their families. It's a time of change that can be both challenging and exciting; in which children and families adjust to new roles, identities and expectations, new interactions and new relationships.

At Woodville, we aim to make this transition as smooth as possible.

As part of Woodville Primary School's Transition Program, preschool children will visit our school for weekly transition sessions beginning Tuesday 11th November 2025. Each visit will be for fifty minutes except for the final Orientation Day visit during which the preschool students will stay from 9.15am to 11am at school.

The aims of this program are for the preschool children to become familiar with the classrooms and school grounds of Woodville Primary School and to familiarise themselves with the teachers they will be working with during first year of schooling. We hope these visits help your child to build a positive rapport with staff and other prep students and will assist your child's transition from preschool to primary school, thus making the move in 2026 a smooth one.

It will be your responsibility to ensure that your child is dropped off and collected on each of the nominated days. Please enter and sign in at the reception office on Warringa Crescent.
